In July and August 2018 you will have received our comprehensive guide for local residents and businesses covering the operation of the new stadium.

Over 60,000 copies were delivered locally and it is still available to view and download at tottenhamhotspur.com/local.

We can now confirm that we shall be holding two test events at our new stadium on Sunday 24 March and Saturday 30 March ahead of our first home game in April.

We shall be hosting a series of drop-in sessions on the stadium's transport operations ahead of the two test events. Our transport team and partners will be on hand to take you through the plans and to answer any questions you may have.

We know many of you are used to living and working alongside the old stadium, but it is important you are aware of these event day measures, particularly for drivers and public transport users. You may wish to travel outside the busiest times before and after events as your journey will be quicker and less crowded. We would encourage you to plan your travel accordingly and apply for the relevant Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) permits that you may need.

In preparation for major event days at the stadium, we would strongly encourage you to:

- Review the guide for local residents and businesses at tottenhamhotspur.com/local to understand the road closures and traffic measures that will be in place.
- Attend a drop-in session.
- Register for updates via tottenhamhotspur.com/local.
- Consider travelling outside the busiest times at primary local stations (White Hart Lane, Northumberland Park, Tottenham Hale and Seven Sisters). They will be extremely busy a couple hours before and after an event as there will be queuing measures in place.

TEST EVENTS

We shall be holding two test events at our new stadium on Sunday 24 March and Saturday 30 March. These events are necessary to achieve the safety approvals ahead of our first home match and allow us to test the new transport measures that will be in effect for major event days.

To help you prepare for the forthcoming test events, the drop-in sessions have been organised to provide you with detailed information regarding travel and road traffic management for major event days at the new stadium to facilitate the 'bedding-in' period and beyond.

BEDDING-IN

Naturally, the stadium's increased capacity will mean more people travelling to the area on a major event day. There will be a 'bedding-in' period for the first few home games as we learn more about how and when supporters choose to travel and the remaining public transport improvement works are completed to local stations (White Hart Lane, Northumberland Park and Tottenham Hale).

There are more options for supporters than ever before, with shuttle buses from Alexandra Palace station and Wood Green station running to the stadium and regional coach services, so it may take a little time for them to research and change their travel habits.

For each test and major event day, Controlled Parking Zones (CPZs), parking suspensions, bus diversions and managed station queuing systems shall be in place. Some local roads will also be subject to temporary closures, including Worcester Avenue, Park Lane, the High Road and Love Lane before, during and after events.
